RE: Revised FY 2019 Curb Replacement Program

The City Council recently awarded a contract for the FY 2019 curb replacement project to Terry Snelling in the amount of \$384,832. This amount was \$215,168 under the \$600,000 budgeted for this project.

Based on the updated curb program adopted by Council this year I am recommending the following streets be added to this year's project.

Walnut Street east of Sunset Lane Derby Street Secretariat Street Oak Drive

The addition of these streets along with programed repairs to ADA curb ramps throughout the City will increase the contract amount to \$574,444. This will leave approximately \$25,000 for unprogrammed repairs.
