BACKGROUND / JUSTIFICATION

Outlined in Raymore City Charter Section 9.3, the City Council shall declare the results of any municipal election at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting.

A municipal election was scheduled to be held on April 7, 2020 for Council members from each of the City's four wards. Given the concern over the outbreak of the Covid-19 virus, Governor Parson issued executive order 20-02, followed by Secretary of State Ashcroft's executive order 20-03, which postponed the April 7 election to June 2. The ballot count included in Bill 3553 at the time of release of the agenda and Council packet are the unofficial results. The official statement of certification of the election results will be distributed before the June 2 Council meeting.

In order to promote efficiency of the City's business items and permit the newly elected officials to begin their terms, Bill 3553 is presented as an emergency reading in its entirety.

BILL 3553

ORDINANCE

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RAYMORE, MISSOURI DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE JUNE 2, 2020, ELECTION AND DECLARING THIS BILL AS AN EMERGENCY."

WHEREAS, a general municipal election was held on June 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.3 of the Raymore City Charter calls for the Council to declare the election results at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting following the election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAYMORE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby found and determined by a canvass of the votes by the City Council of the City of Raymore, Missouri, at the election held on June 2, 2020, in conformity with the Comprehensive Election Act of 1977; Revised Statutes of Missouri; the provisions of the Charter; and Ordinances of the City of Raymore as follows:

Councilmember from Ward 1	2-Year Term

The City Council does find that Reginald Townsend is the candidate for Councilmember Ward 1 who received the highest number of votes and shall hold the office for a two-year term, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

The City Council does find that Tom Circo is the candidate for Councilmember from Ward 2 who received the highest number of votes and shall hold the office for a two-year term, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

The City Council does find that Jay Holman is the candidate for Councilmember from Ward 3, who received the highest number of votes and shall hold the office for a two-year term, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

The City Council does find that Sonja Abdelgawad is the candidate for Councilmember from Ward 4, who received the highest number of votes and shall hold the office for a two-year term, until a successor is duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

Section 2. It is further found, declared, and determined that notice of said election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri governing elections and subject to the provisions for Charter Cities.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. Emergency Reading. This Bill is declared and authorized as an emergency, and will be read in its entirety, to promote the administration of government and permit the newly elected officials to begin their terms.

Section 5. Effective Date. The effective date of approval of this Ordinance shall be coincidental with the Mayor's signature and attestation by the City Clerk.
