Staff recommends retaining HDR, Inc. to assist with assembling the necessary traffic and economic benefit data necessary to complete the application. HDR is currently working with the City of Belton for the study and design of their outer belt area. To ensure this project begins in a timely manner, the Mayor declares this Bill as an emergency nature.

Councilmember Burke asked how the current stay at home orders and reduction of vehicles on roads would affect getting accurate traffic counts.

Mr. Feuerborn stated traffic counts on I-49 at the interchange should be fairly accurate. When the study begins, it is anticipated that the stay at home orders will be lifted and traffic will be at normal volumes. The City has heard from the Federal government advising to proceed with submitting the grant in the current cycle even though grant funding may be suspended given the current atmosphere.
