Section 22.01 – Qualifications to Attend

- A. The applicant must not have a criminal history.
- B. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
 - 1. This may be waived for persons 16-17 years old with the approval of a parent or legal guardian, to include their signature on the application form.
- C. All applications will be approved by the Chief of Police or designee.

Section 22.02 – Department Member Responsibilities
