A. Officers will coordinate search for the device with the owner or responsible party of the structure affected by the threat. Areas will not necessarily be evacuated unless the owner or responsible party desires to evacuate the structure, or if an explosive device is found.

*B. Oversized structures, such as large stores and schools may require a large-scale effort to effectively conduct a search of the premises. In this situation, a "unified command" style of operation may be employed to ensure a coordinated effort among searchers. Other agencies with whom Raymore has mutual aid agreements may be requested for assistance.
