



PUBLIC NOTICE

Vacancy on Raymore City Council

Councilmember Dale Jacobson announced his resignation effective May 31, 2021. In accordance with City Charter Section 3.7 and City Code Section 110.145, public notice is hereby given of a vacancy on the City Council. The Council will receive applications for the position for a period of fourteen (14) days until 5:00 p.m. on June 17, 2021, at Raymore City Hall.

Applicants for this vacancy must meet the following qualifications:

- Must be at least 25 years of age prior to taking office
- Must be a United States citizen
- Must have been a resident of the City for a minimum of two (2) years
- Must have been a resident of Ward 1 (one) for a minimum of six (6) months
- Must not be in arrears for any State income, personal property, municipal, or real property taxes; liens, forfeiture or defalcation in office; past or present corporate officer of any fee office that owes any tax to the State of Missouri.
- Must not have been convicted of or pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor under the Federal laws of the United States of America or to a felony under the laws of the State of Missouri or an offense committed in another State that would be considered a felony in this State
- Must be a registered voter in Ward 1 (one)
- Must not hold any compensated elected governmental office
- Must not be employed by the City of Raymore

The City Council by majority vote of all of its remaining members shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy until the next regular municipal election in April 2022, at which time the seat shall be up for election for the one (1)-year unexpired term.

After the deadline for applications, the Council shall give public notice of those persons who applied for the position and notice of when the Council will hold a public meeting to interview applicants and receive information from Ward 1 (one) residents who are eligible to vote. Thereafter, the Council will appoint a qualified applicant to fill the vacancy or, if the Council finds no qualified person has applied, repeat the foregoing process until a qualified applicant has been appointed.
