### Upcoming

- **HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:** City Hall and City offices will be closed Thursday, Dec. 30 and Friday, Dec. 31 for the New Years holiday. **Residential trash service will run on a regular schedule.**
- **WINTER WEATHER ALERT for late Friday, Dec. 31 into Jan. 1:** Winter weather is on the way this weekend, with a mixed bag of precipitation anticipated to start late Friday night that will transition to snow.

Public Works professionals will be ringing in the new year working this winter weather event, with snow shifts mobilizing starting at 7 p.m. Friday, Dec. 31, and working around the clock for the duration of the event.
