E. Budget Amendment and Purchase of 216 S. Adams Street

City Attorney Jonathan Zerr provided a review of the staff report included in the packet. In October 2022, City staff began discussions with John Patrick Horan and Mary Elaine Horan regarding property currently listed for sale located at 216 S. Adams Street. The property is on the west side of Adams Street and in the southeast quadrant, across the street from the playground at T.B. Hanna Station. The purchase of this property allows for future expansion of the park. The purchase of this property requires a budget amendment to Fund 45 of the FY22 budget. The current fund balance is \$1,463,805, of which \$85,000 will be used to fund the purchase of this property. If approved, the City will maintain the property according to park maintenance standards until updated plans for the area are approved by the

Parks and Recreation Board. City staff requests approval of the real estate sale contract and budget amendment.

F. Sunset Lane Eminent Domain Property Acquisition

BILL 3758: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RAYMORE, MISSOURI, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INITIATE THE PROCEDURES REQUIRED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 523 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF MISSOURI FOR THE ACQUISITION OF ALL NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY, TEMPORARY EASEMENTS AND PERMANENT EASEMENTS TO COMPLETE THE EXTENSION OF SUNSET LANE."

City Clerk Erica Hill conducted the first reading of Bill 3758 by title only.

City Attorney Jonathan Zerr provided a review of the staff report included in the packet. On August 4, 2020, the citizens of Raymore, Missouri, voted to approve the issuance of general obligation bonds for street and park improvements including the extension of Sunset Lane from its current terminus to 163rd Street. The City has completed the necessary engineering work for the improvements contemplated. These improvements will include construction of the roadway, installation of storm sewer controls, and installation of sidewalks and/or trails. The project will require the acquisition of additional right-of-way, temporary easements, and permanent easements. Most of these have been acquired from property owners through negotiation and/or the development process. One final segment remains to be acquired. Staff has been diligently working on negotiating for the purchase of the same since July of 2022 with limited success. The City has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Blue Springs Safety Storage South, LLC for the development of the residential subdivision identified by Preliminary Plat as Madison Valley Phase 2, which will be constructed along a portion of the eastern side of Sunset Lane. The City has limited access by the MOU for construction and residence access to Sunset Lane which further necessitates the completion of the roadway. In order to maintain the timely completion of Sunset Lane, and to obtain

the necessary right-of-way and easements in a fiscally responsible manner, City staff is seeking authorization to initiate the eminent domain procedures authorized by Chapter 523 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri for the remaining segment.
