Public Works Director Mike Krass provided a review of the staff report included in the Council packet. The City participates in the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) Solid Waste Management District Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program on an annual basis. This program allows Raymore residents to participate in several HHW drop off events held throughout the metropolitan area including an event that alternates between Raymore and Belton. Residents also have access to permanent HHW drop off locations throughout the metropolitan area that can be used year-round. The budget for this service is \$28,000 and this year's agreement is \$26,580.40. MARC calculates the annual fee for this service based on a per capita rate of \$1.10 multiplied by the 2021 estimated population for our community (24,164). Previous (2019) MARC calculated rates were based on a per capita rate of \$1.07 multiplied by the 2018 Census' estimated population for our community (21,784). Staff answered questions from Council.

# D. Support for a Proposed Bellah Terra Subdivision in Cass County, MO

RESOLUTION 23-03: "A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROPOSED BELLAH TERRA RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION ABUTTING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF RAYMORE IN CASS COUNTY, MISSOURI."

City Clerk Erica Hill conducted the reading of Resolution 23-03 by title only.

Development Services Director David Gress provided a review of the staff report included in the Council packet. Troy Bellah, representing Bellah Homes and the developer of the proposed Bellah Terra subdivision, located within Cass County, MO, south of Hubach Hill Road, east of the Tiffany Manor subdivision, has requested a letter of support from the City of Raymore, pursuant to Cass County Zoning Code 405.020C(7)a, which states that: The Zoning Officer shall submit the proposed Preliminary or Final Plat, as submitted by the Applicant, to the municipality located within one and one-half (1 1/2) mile of the subject property for a review period of fifteen (15) days, at the end of which period, any comments received in writing from the municipality shall be included in the application summary review prepared for the Planning Board hearing. In lieu of written comments, representatives of the municipality may appear at the Public Hearing before the Board and present its recommendation, or may elect to make no comments regarding said request. Resolution 23-03 indicates that the proposed subdivision, while located outside the jurisdictional boundaries of the City of Raymore, is consistent with the Growth Management Plan, which identifies this area as appropriate for low-density rural residential development, and allows the Mayor to provide the attached Letter of Support to the Cass County Commission.

Councilmember Abdelgawad stated the northern edge is Hubach Hill Road, but asked what the southern border of the project is. Developer Troy Bellah stated it is 195th Street.

Councilmember Forster asked if we approve the letter of support, would it only apply to this plan or any subdivision that could be developed in that location in the future.

Troy Bellah, 1248 SW Wisteria Drive, Lee's Summit, MO, responded to Councilmember Forster by reviewing the process required by the County for this project.

Councilmember Berendzen asked if there has been testing on the soil for the septic systems. Mr. Bellah stated yes, it's been submitted and approved by MO Department of Natural Resources.

Councilmember Holman asked if this subdivision requested to be annexed in the future, would engineering needs would need to be met to be compliant with city codes. Mr. Krass stated that a sewer system to that property would be extremely expensive and difficult.
