Re: Feather Flag Purchase

Commission Chair Bob Berry wishes to purchase feather flags to promote concerts sponsored by the Raymore Arts Commission. The flags would be placed at the 58 Highway and Johnston Parkway intersection (not in the island, but on either side of the street at least 12 feet from the corner so as not to interfere with the right-of-way visibility) and/or at the park entrance.

The flag would say CONCERT TONIGHT in large lettering with AT THE PARK in smaller font and the Raymore City logo and would only be displayed on the same day of a concert.

Staff is seeking direction on the number of flags and the size of flags if the commission wishes to make the purchase. Pricing as follows:

15' feather flag with hardware: \$270.20 9' feather flag with hardware: \$211.40
