PRIMARY ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

LAND USE & DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVIEW

- Analyzes and reviews development proposals or applications such as rezoning requests, preliminary and final plats, minor subdivisions, architectural reviews, development permits, variance applications, and other applications for compliance with appropriate planning principles, regulations, and policies.
- Coordinates outside review for all development applications and distributes comments internally and externally. Confirms completeness of all land use and development applications. Meets with and assists applicants in finding solutions to development issues.
- Develops, reviews and implements comprehensive plans, zoning regulations, and land use policies to guide the growth and development of the city.

TECHNICAL WRITING & COMMUNICATION

- Prepares staff comments, reports, and recommendations to the Planning Commission, City Council, Board of Adjustment and other boards and committees as necessary.
- Advises the public, including residents, architects, builders, contractors, and engineers on the city's Comprehensive Plan, development policies, procedures, and standards and other land use matters including the current zoning of property.
- Designs illustrative graphics, planning diagrams and presentation materials for public hearings and meetings.
- Adapts communication styles and format for the audience to which they are presenting or communicating.
- Prepares text amendments to existing zoning ordinances, including land use regulations, subdivision design regulations, and development regulations.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

- Oversees planning and development projects, and acts as a liaison between various city departments and project applicants, developers, engineers etc...
- Organizes and facilitates meetings with developers and community groups to introduce and discuss new development proposals and planning projects.
- Prepares and publishes legal notices, manages notification to property owners, prepares agendas and drafts minutes for Planning Commission and Board of Zoning Adjustment.
- Works collaboratively and extensively across other departments to ensure infrastructure and construction is consistent with development plans.

DATA ANALYSIS & CRITICAL THINKING

- Analyzes demographic, economic, and environmental data to inform planning decisions and recommendations.
- Researches and prepares master plans, long-range planning studies, ordinance amendments, and reports on other planning issues.
- Researches local, regional and national planning issues, and provides related technical summaries or reports to other departments, boards, or commissions.
- Identifies community problems, issues, and opportunities in particular neighborhoods that could be mitigated through better community planning.
- Maintains a thorough understanding of land use regulations and other statutory requirements and the ability to interpret and apply them to development projects.
