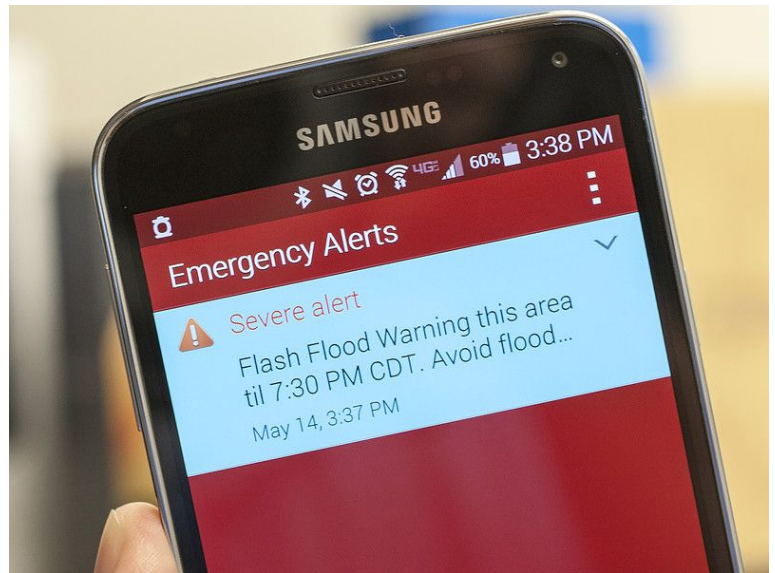

The commission also recommended approval of the rezoning of land bounded by Maple Street, Olive Street, Washington Street and Adams Street from "R-1/OT" Single Family Residential/Original Town Overlay District and "C-1/OT" Neighborhood Commercial/Original Town Overlay District to "PR" Parks, Recreation and Public Use District. City Council will consider the applications on March 13.
