Join Raymore Parks & Recreation and become part of the second annual Raymore Christmas Tree Trail at T.B. Hanna Station. Imagine transforming our park into a winter wonderland with holiday trees decorated by some of Raymore's favorite organizations and businesses.

We want you to create something fun, come up with a theme, promote your organization or cause and become part of a fun holiday tradition. All you will need is a tree, some lights and a little creativity. We will provide the electricity at the park. We will officially light all of the trees on Dec. 1 at 6 p.m. as part of the Mayor's Tree Lighting ceremony.

Rules & Requirements

- **1.** Selected trees should be artificial and prepared to handle outdoor elements for three weeks. Trees should be no smaller than 36 inches or no taller than 10 feet. Anchoring your tree with weights or in ground stakes is highly recommended.
- 2. Lighting should be LED only. Please do not use more than six, 100-light strands per tree. Any more than this could cause the entire display to fail. Every tree will be allowed one plug-in. Owners will be responsible for getting power from the tree to the junction box (approximately 3-12 feet). Decorations and lights should be rated for outdoor use.
- **3.** Theme/decorations should be family friendly.
- **4.** The City of Raymore and the Parks & Recreation Department are not responsible for any loss or damage to a tree, decorations, lights, anchors or power cord from the junction box.
- Trees must be delivered to the site of T.B. Hanna Station on Dec. 1 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Trees will be connected to power until Wednesday, Dec. 27. Trees must be picked up between Dec. 27 and Dec. 29. Other arrangements may be possible in an emergency.
- **6.** If you choose to display signage naming business/organization, limit the sign size to two feet by two feet.
