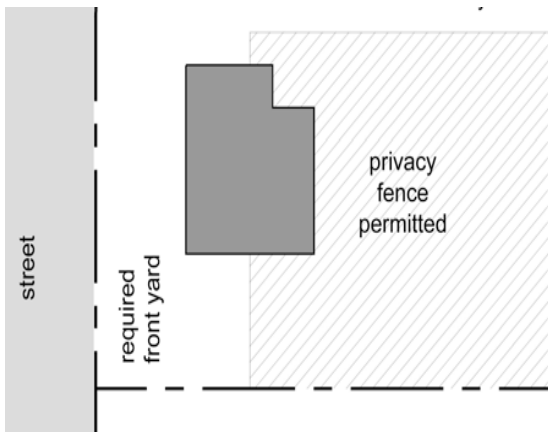

Any decorative fence (4 feet or less) may be installed on any portion of a lot, with restrictions (see fence flyer). A decorative fence is an open fence, other than chain link, that is no more than 66% opaque intended to decorate, accent, or frame a feature of the landscape. Decorative fences include but shall not be limited to split rail, picket, wrought iron and similar open fences. For a picket fence to be considered decorative, the gap between pickets must be at least 1/2 width of a picket.

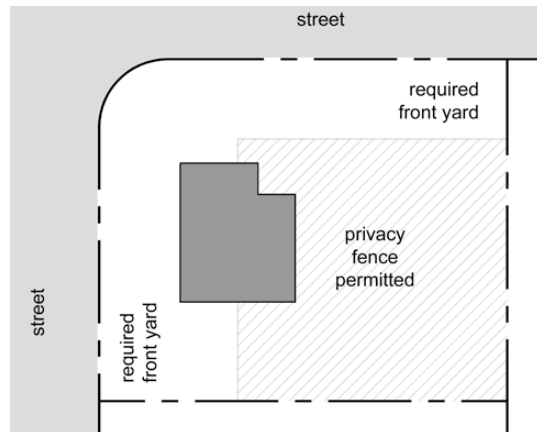
It is the responsibility of the party applying for the permit to know where property lines are located.
