- 1. Mike reported an upward trend in applications to show artwork in our available gallery spaces.

- 3. We discussed ways to promote school district art events through our social media and publications. While notices of school art events could be promoted through our social media, school events are a closed and secured ecosystem that might not lend itself to visitors other than students, teachers and family members. We decided to table this idea for now.

- 5. Mike reported that an annual city survey is being mailed to select Raymore citizens and will include four questions about arts in Raymore. (Up from zero questions last year!)
